Alexandrina	8m	8m	Large tulip-shaped purplish-pink blooms with white interior.	Round	5
Ann	3.5m	2.5m	Red pink flowers remain upright, flowering mid April.	Upright	5
Betty	3m	2.5m	Large abundant reddish-purple flowers.	Round	5
Butterflies	8.5m	6m	Covered with small, pale yellow blooms in spring.	Round	5
Jane	3.5m	2.5m	Blooms red-purple on the outside, white inside; very fragrant.	Upright	5
Randy	4m	3.5m	Reddish-purple petals with white interior. Blooms later and longer than most magnolias.	Round	5
Ricki	5m	2m	Bloom pink with interior to red-purple.	Round	5
Royal Star	5m	3m	Double pure white flowers in April. Dark green leaves turn bronze in fall.	Round	5
Saucer	6m	3m	Immense waxy pink & white blooms before leaves in spring.	Round	4
Susan	2.5m	2.5m	Red-purple buds open to large dark pink blooms.	Upright, Spreading	4
Yellow Bird	13m	8m	Canary yellow upright blooms.	Upright	4

Leonard Messel	5m	7m	Deep pink buds open to pink blooms with white center. Breathtaking in early spring.	Round	5
Merrill	13m	10m	White star-like blossoms in early spring. A rapid grower with dense branching.	Upright, Round	4
Royal Star	5m	3m	Double pure white flowers in April. Dark green leaves turn bronze in fall.	Round	5
Waterlily	6m	5m	Buds are pale pink, opening to white; highly fragrant. Later blooming than other star types.	Round, Oval	4
