Autumn Purple Ash	16m	10m	Seedless. Beautiful reddish-purple fall colour.	Oval	4
Black Ash	15m	10m	Native. Grows well in range of soils. Dark red fall colour.	Narrow/Open	1
Blue Ash	13m	10m	Twigs have four-sided appearance. Yellow fall colour.	Oval	4
Fall Gold Black Ash	17m	13m	Yellow fall colour, seedless.	Upright	3
Golden Desert Ash	10m	7m	New growth gold, fading to limey, bark golden.	Round	3
Green Ash	18m	10m	Adaptable to most conditions. Yellow fall colour.	Round	2
Patmore Ash	17m	8m	Seedless, fast growing. Shiny foliage and yellow fall colour.	Narrow/Pyramid	2
Summit Ash	17m	8m	Hardy seedless ash. Yellow fall colour.	Upright	4
White Ash	21m	20m	Fast growing native tree. Adapts to most soils. Yellow in fall.	Upright/Oval	3

Burr Oak	18m	13m	Hardest native Oak. Grows in range of soils. Interesting bark.	Upright/Spreading	3
Crimson Spire English Oak	25m	3m	Tall, narrow pyramidal habit. Brilliant red fall colour.	Narrow/Pyramid	5
English Oak	18m	13m	Broad, rounded canopy. Some foliage persists through winter.	Round	5
Green Pillar Pin Oak	23m	6m	Strong pyramidal shape with glossy foliage. Red fall colour.	Pyramid	4
Pin Oak	25m	13m	Horizontal branches with red leaves in fall. Great shade tree.	Pyramid	4
Pyramidal English Oak	15m	5m	Hardy pyramidal tree. Some foliage remains in winter.	Narrow	5
Red Oak	16m	15m	Beautiful red fall colour gives very attractive appearance.	Round	4
Regal Prince Pyramidal Oak	20m	7m	Handsome, vigorous tree with superb mildew resistance. Cross between Swamp White Oak and Pyramidal English Oak.	Upright/Oval	4
Scarlet Oak	15m	15m	Fast growing; favours moist soils. Best fall colour of all Oaks.	Upright, Spread	4
Skyrocket English Oak	20m	5m	Narrower than 'Pyramidal.' Some foliage persists in winter.	Narrow/Pyramid	5
Swamp White Oak	15m	15m	Natural habitat is low-lying areas. Yellow-brown to reddish in fall.	Round/Open	4
White Oak	20m	20m	A strong disease resistant and drought tolerant tree, orange red fall colour. Majestic and long-lived.	Round	4

Common Thornless Honeylocust	17m	13m	A favourite street tree. Fallen leaves disappear in grass.	Open/Spreading	4
Imperial Honeylocust	10m	10m	Graceful, spreading branches. Compact with dainty leaves.	Compact	4
Northern Acclaim Honeylocust	15m	11m	The hardest Honeylocust. Yellow fall colour.	Pyramid	3
Shademaster Honeylocust	17m	10m	Symmetrical, fast growing. Casts filtered shade; good for lawns.	Open/Spreading	4
Skyline Honeylocust	15m	13m	Stately & unusual with distinct pyramidal form.	Pyramid	4

Sunburst Honeylocust	15m	13m	Vibrant yellow foliage in spring turns light green in summer.	Pyramid	4
