Beni Schichihenge	4.5m	6m	Green leaves with irregular white variegation. New growth in summer bright pink. Vivid orange fall colour. A true showpiece.	Upright	Part Sun
Bloodgood	6m	5m	The most popular upright, with deep purple leaves all season.	Round/Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Boskoop Glory	5m	4m	Wine red leaves in spring turn bronze green in summer, orange red in fall. Heat tolerant.	Upright/Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Burgundy Lace	4m	3m	Large, deeply cut leaves are burgundy in spring, orange in fall.	Upright/Broad	Sun/Part Sun
Butterfly	3m	2m	Petite; vase shaped with small, variegated leaves.	Vase	Part Sun
Crimson Prince	4m	3m	Smaller form of Bloodgood with finer, purple leaves.	Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Emperor I	6m	5m	Deep red leaves that emerge two weeks after Bloodgood. Less susceptible to frost damage. Vigorous grower.	Upright	
Enkan (ribbonleaf)	3m	2m	Small, shrub-like upright with extremely fine red foliage.	Rounded	Sun/Part Sun
Fireglow	4m	3m	Rich, cherry red foliage holds colour very well. Denser and more compact than Bloodgood. Brilliant scarlet fall colour.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Golden (Aureum)	3m	2m	Leaves bright yellow in spring, fading to lime in summer.	Upright	Part Sun
Iijima Sunago	4m	3m	Leaves chocolate brown with green veins, speckled with yellow. Name means "Gold Dust of Iijima." Yellow/orange in fall.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Japanese Maple (straight species)	8m	6m	Foliage is light green. Adds artistry to any garden. Vigorous.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Katsura	5m	4m	In spring leaves are yellow edged with orange, then fade to lime in summer. Brilliant shades of yellow and orange in fall.	Vase	Part Sun
Mikawa Yatsubusa	2.5m	2m	Tightly layered bright green leaves adorn short, stocky branches. Fall colours yellow-orange. An outstanding selection.	Compact/Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Moonfire	4m	4m	Rounded, shrubby tree with deep purple foliage that holds over the whole season. An old favourite.	Upright/Round	Sun/Part Sun

Omura Yama	4.5m	2m	Weeping willow-like; upright growth and pendulous, weeping branches. Leaves green in summer and gold/red in fall.	Upright/Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Orange Dream	4m	3m	Chartreuse green leaves in summer, riotous orange in fall. Needs shelter from afternoon sun.	Upright/Round	Part Sun
Orido Nishiki	5m	4m	Leaves variegated pink and white. Yellow/orange/red in fall.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Osakazuki	5m	4m	Green leaves turn brilliant crimson in fall. A real showstopper.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Oshio Beni	6m	5m	Upright with bronze coloured leaves. Bright scarlet in fall.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun
Red Emperor	5m	5m	Similar to Emperor I, but shorter and more rounded in shape.	Upright/Round	Sun/Part Sun
Red Pygmy (ribbonleaf)	2m	2m	Maroon leaves very narrow; red fall colour. Dwarf; shrublike.	Rounded	Sun/Part Sun
Red Spider (ribbonleaf)	4m	3m	Extremely fine, finger-like leaves emerge red/orange; red fall colour. A rare Canadian introduction.	Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Sango Kaku (Coralbark)	7m	4m	Very vigorous grower with light green leaves that turn yellow/red/orange in fall. In winter stems are vivid coral red.	Upright/Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Scolopendrifolium (ribbonleaf)	4m	3m	Dense grower with fine, light green leaves. Golden fall colour.	Upright/Round	Sun/Part Sun
Shaina	2.5m	3m	New foliage red, fades to maroon, scarlet in fall. Very dwarf.	Spreading	Part Sun
Sherwood Flame	6m	5m	Maroon leaves in spring, red/green in summer, red in fall.	Upright/Broad	Sun/Part Sun
Shindeshojo	3m	2m	Famous for flaming scarlet new growth. Smaller than most.	Rounded	Part Sun
Shirazz	6m	4m	Leaves emerge wine-red with pink margin, fade to green with white margin. Shelter from winds and afternoon sun.	Upright/Round	Part Sun
Shojo Nomura	6m	4m	Upright with deep red leaves, turning fiery orange in fall.	Upright/Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Skeeter's Broom	2.5m	2m	Dwarf form of Bloodgood. Smaller, deep purple leaves. Dense.	Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Suminagashi	7m	5m	A large upright with red-purple spring leaves; scarlet in fall.	Upright/Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Taylor	4m	3m	Small, bushy upright with green leaves edged in pink. Colourful.	Upright	Part Sun
Tobiosho	6m	5m	Famous for electric scarlet fall colour. Green leaves in summer.	Upright	Sun/Part Sun

Villa Taranto (ribbonleaf)	3.5m	3m	Narrow leaves emerge red, fade to green, yellow in fall. Bushy.	Upright/Round	Sun/Part Sun

Crimson Princess	1m	2m	Vigorous weeping form with red spring foliage; orange in fall.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Crimson Queen	1.75m	1.75m	Low growing tree with weeping habit. Dissected purple leaves.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Everred	3m	3m	Finely dissected red leaves. Delicate appearance.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Garnet	3m	4m	Larger and more upright than other weeping forms. Red leaves.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Orangeola	1.5m	2m	Tight, dense weeping habit with small, fine leaves. In spring leaves orange/red, green in summer, pumpkin orange in fall.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Red Select (Inaba Shidare)	2-3m	2-3m	Purple-red laceleaf holds colour all through summer. Stunning.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Seiryu	8m	5m	Unique upright-growing green laceleaf. Extremely vigorous.	Upright/Vase	Sun/Part Sun
Stella Rossa	1.5m	1.5m	Maroon leaves, performs better in full sun. Means 'Red Star.'	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Tamukeyama	1.5m	1.5m	Deep red throughout season. Known since 1860's.	Weeping	Sun/Part Sun
Viridis	2m	2 -3m	Bright green laceleaf that turns golden in fall. Great in shade.	Weeping	Sun/Shade
Waterfall	2-3m	3m	Cascading form with large green leaves that turn in yellow fall.	Weeping	Sun/Shade

Autumn Moon	2.5m	2.5m	New leaves emerge with the colours of fall; orange, yellow and red. Vivid orange again in fall. Shelter from afternoon sun.	Round	Part Sun
Fernleaf (Aconitifolium)	5m	5m	Broad tree with large, dissected leaves and horizontal branching. Also called 'Dancing Peacock.' Lovely orange/red in fall.	Upright/Round	Sun/Part Sun
Golden Fullmoon	5m	4m	Rounded leaves emerge yellow, fade to lime -green and turn vivid orange in fall. Shade from afternoon sun.	Upright	Part Sun
Jordan	4m	3m	Round, bushy tree with bright yellow leaves. Sun tolerant.	Round	Sun/Part Sun
