Cortland	5m	4m	Large red apple, sweet and tart, white flesh. Good for eating, cooking and cider. Late September.	Braeburn, Fuji, Gala, Golden Delicious, Honey Crisp, Jonamac, McIntosh, Red Delicious, Spartan . Most white-blossom crabapples will also pollinate.	4
Hazen (semi-dwarf)	5m	4m	Dark red, medium firm, juicy. Good for eating, desert, cooking. Late August.	Cortland , Jazz, Granny Smith, Ida Red, McIntosh, Paula Red, Spartan , Winecrisp. Most whiteblossom crabapples will also pollinate.	4
Mutsu (Crispin)	6m	4m	Very large green-yellow fruit. Good for eating, cooking, baking. Mid-October.	Cortland , Empire, Fuji, Golden Russet, Granny Smith, Honeycrisp, Jonathan, McIntosh, Red Delicious, Winecrisp. Most white-blossom crabapples and Dolgo Crabapple will also pollinate. NOTE: Mutsu is a tri-pollinator that requires two other varieties to produce fruit.	5
Northern Spy	5m	4m	Large red apple, tart, firm flesh. Old-time favourite desert and baking apple. Mid-October.	Braeburn, Fuji, Golden Delicious, Honeycrisp, Jonamac. Most white-blossom crabapples will also pollinate.	4
Red Delicious	5m	4m	Large red apple. Crisp skin with soft, sweet flesh. Good eating and desert apple. Great pollinizer. Late September.	Braeburn, Cortland , Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Honeycrisp, Jazz, Jonathan, Northern Spy, Spartan , Winecrisp. Most white-blossom crabapples will also pollinate.	5
Spartan	5m	4m	Medium size, dark red, McIntosh type with juicy, sweet flesh. Fresh eating & baking. Stores well. Early October.	Braeburn, Cortland , Fuji, Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Honey Crisp, Red Delicious, Winecrisp. Most white-blossom crabapples and Dolgo Crabapple will also pollinate. NOTE: Spartan is partially fertile, but benefits from having another pollinator.	5

Haroblush	4m	3m	Medium size, red blush, freestone. Fresh eating, drying, canning. Late July. Resistant to canker.	Self-pollinating	4
Harostar	4m	3m	Freestone Fresh eating, drying, canning. Beginning of August. Resistant to bacterial spot, brown rot and skin cracking.	Self-pollinating	5

Earlidade	7m	7m	Deed redskin, yellow flesh. Sweet, smooth texture. Semiclingstone. Late July.	Self-pollinating	5

August Rose	3m		White flesh, firm, freestone, melting texture. Mid to late August. Tolerant to bacterial leaf spot and constriction canker.	Self-pollinating	5
PEAR					
Anjou	6m	5m	Light green skin, mild flavour, firm flesh. Stores very well. Increased resistance to fire blight. Early October.	Bartlett, Bennett, Bosc, Clapp's Favorite, Flemish Beauty , Red Clapps	5
Bosc	6m	5m	Green-brown fruit with flavourful flesh. Long storage life. Popular desert pear. Productive tree. Early October.	Anjou , Bartlett, Bennett, Clapp's Favorite, Flemish Beauty , Red Clapps	5
Clapp	6m	5m	Cold hardy variety with large yellow fruit. Very productive. Does well in heavy soil. Early September.	Anjou , Bartlett, Bennett, Bosc, Flemish Beauty , Red Clapps,	4
Flemish Beauty	6m	5m	The hardiest variety. Medium green fruit with red blush. Pick as soon as it ripens. Late September.	Anjou , Ayers, Bartett, Bennett, Bosc, Clapp's Favorite , Red Clapp	4

Damson	6m	5m	Small/medium, purple-blue skin, yellow fruit, semi-freestone. Best used for preserves, wine. Mid-September.	Self-pollinating	5
Stanley	8m	6m	Medium/large, deep purple-blue skin, green/yellow flesh, juicy & sweet, freestone. Best used fresh, dried, canning. Heavy producer. Mid-September.	Self-pollinating. Will benefit from pollination with Vibrant, Violette	5
Valo Myro			Medium/large, purple skin, yellow flesh, semi-clingstone, sweet. Mid-September.	Self-pollinating. Will benefit from pollination with other European plums such as Italian, Stanley, Valerie, Vanette, Vibrant, Violette	4
Vanette	6m	5m	Medium/large, purple-blue skin, freestone, sweet. Best used fresh, dried, preserves, canning. Mid-August.	Mount Royal, Stanley, Valor, Vibrant, Victory, Violette, Vision, Voyageur	5
