Dwarf Alberta Spruce	2m	1.25m	Narrow, conical. Slow growing green grass-like foliage.	Pyramid	4
Fat Albert Spruce	5m	2.5m	Very slow growing. Maintains shape well. Blue.	Broad/Conical	3
Hoopsi Blue Spruce	20m	6m	Intense blue foliage. Good as specimen.	Pyramid	2
Jean's Dilly White Spruce	2m	1.2m	Needles at the end of shoots have distinct twist. Very slow growth.	Upright/Narrow	4
Norway Spruce	25m	10m	Tall, rapid growing. Used as windbreak or specimen plant.	Pyramid	2
Pyramidal Norway Spruce	5m	2.5m	Compact pyramidal spruce that is used as a specimen.	Pyramid	2
Pyramidal Spruce	6m	2.5m	Pyramidal habit. Steel blue foliage. Good as a specimen.	Upright/Narrow	2
Serbian Spruce	21m	4.5m	Ornamental spruce with silvery green foliage.	Pyramid	5
Weeping Norway Spruce	5m	4m	Specimen tree with weeping branches. Stake for shape.	Weeping	3
Weeping White Spruce	4m	3m	Distinct narrow selection with pendulous branches.	Weeping	2
White Spruce	25m	4.5m	Hardy, shapely tree. Dark green needles. Windbreak/specimen.	Pyramid	2
