



Panicle

Hydrangea paniculata sp.

- Commonly called Peegee hydrangea
- Blooms on new wood: prune late winter or early spring
- Varieties: Bobo, Limelight, Little Lime, Pinky Winky, Quick Fire, Zinfin Doll, Little Quick Fire



Climbing

Hydrangea petiolaris

- Prune for maintenance & size immediately after blooming
- May take time to mature before blooming



Bigleaf

Hydrangea macrophylla sp.

- Also called mophead, hortensia, florists' hydrangea
- Blooms on old wood: do not prune
- Varieties: Pink Beauty, Nikko Blue, Cityline Series

Hydrangea serrata sp.

• Blooms on old wood: do not prune

Oakleaf

Hydrangea quercifolia sp.

• Blooms on old wood: do not prune



Smooth

Hydrangea arborescens sp.

- Also called Annabelle
- Blooms on new wood: prune late winter or early spring
- Varieties: Incrediball series, Invicibelle series



Reblooming

Hydrangea macrophylla sp. Hydrangea serrata sp.

- Bloom on both old and new wood
- Prune for maintenance immediately after flowering; prune to remove winter damage in early spring
- Varieties: Endless Summer series, Let's Dance series
