



### Panicle

*Hydrangea paniculata* sp.

- Commonly called Peegee hydrangea
- Blooms on new wood: prune late winter or early spring
- Varieties: Bobo, Limelight, Little Lime, Pinky Winky, Quick Fire, Zinfin Doll, Little Quick Fire



### Climbing

*Hydrangea petiolaris*

- Prune for maintenance & size immediately after blooming
- May take time to mature before blooming



### Bigleaf

*Hydrangea macrophylla* sp.

- Also called mophead, hortensia, florists' hydrangea
- Blooms on old wood: do not prune
- Varieties: Pink Beauty, Nikko Blue, Cityline Series



### Lacecap & Mountain

*Hydrangea serrata* sp.

- Blooms on old wood: do not prune

# Hydrangeas

## Understanding Their Differences

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### Oakleaf

*Hydrangea quercifolia* sp.

- Blooms on old wood: do not prune



### Smooth

*Hydrangea arborescens* sp.

- Also called Annabelle
- Blooms on new wood: prune late winter or early spring
- Varieties: Incrediball series, Invicibelle series



### Reblooming

*Hydrangea macrophylla* sp.

*Hydrangea serrata* sp.

- Bloom on both old and new wood
- Prune for maintenance immediately after flowering; prune to remove winter damage in early spring
- Varieties: Endless Summer series, Let's Dance series
