



Lawn Care Basics



Spring (Mid-May)

Fertilizer: Nutrite Spring Lawn Fertilizer 21-0-9

Overseed: to thicken lawn with Connon Quick Over-Seed

Less than 5 hours of sun? We recommend Connon Super Shade Grass Seed

Weed Control: (DO NOT APPLY WEED CONTROL AND GRASS SEED IN THE SAME SEASON)

Crabgrass: To reduce crabgrass Turf-SharkCorn Gluten 9-0-0 can be applied as a pre-emergent

Broadleaf Weeds: (Dandelion) Use Scotts Weed-B-Gon, two application required

Insects: Grubs- in spring use Scotts Grub-B-Gon

Early Summer (Late-June)

Fertilizer: Nutrite Summer Lawn Fertilizer 18-0-12

Weed Control: Use Scotts Weed-B-Gon

Insects: Grubs, Use Scotts Grub-B-Gon

Late Summer (Early-Mid September)

Aerate (core aeration is best)

Top dress: Use compost such as Turf-Shark Granular Compost Top Dressing

Overseed: to thicken lawn with Connon Quick Over-Seed

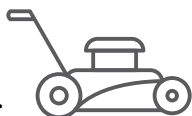
Less than 5 hours of sun? Use Connon Super Shade Grass Seed

*This is the best time of year to apply grass seed – especially beneath trees

Fall (Mid-October)

Fertilizer: Nutrite Fall Lawn Fertilizer 10-0-15

Mowing



- Mowing height 3 to 3½ inches
- Little longer in the summer
- Checked mower blade regularly
- Sharpen the blade after 20 hours of mowing (at least annually)

Watering



- 2.5 cm (1”) per week
- Every 5 – 7 days
- Mornings are best

Seeding



- Mid to late May or,
 - September is best
 - 10° C Soil temperature for germination
- Water New Seed**
- 15 minutes daily for 3 weeks
 - Twice a day in hot weather
