BLUEBERRIES					
ANGUSTIFOLIUM (LOWBUSH)	60cm	60cm	Blueberry plants grow best in an acidic, well-drained, moist soil.	Full sun/Shade	1
BLUE CROP (HIGHBUSH)	1.75m	2m	Mid-season with consistent yields and disease resistant.	Full sun/Part shade	4
CHANDLER (HIGHBUSH)	1.8m	1.8m	Large, super sweet berries, bushy and compact with red fall color.	Full sun/Part shade	6
CHIPPEWA (HIGHBUSH)	90cm	1.2m	Large quantities of firm sweet sky blue berries in early summer.	Full sun/Part shade	3
DUKE (HIGHBUSH)	1.5m	2m	An early season self-pollinating variety. Highly productive, vigorous.	Full sun/Part shade	4
PATRIOT (HIGHBUSH)	1.5m	1.2m	Early season. Very large berries, up to the size of a quarter.	Full sun/Part shade	4
PEACH SORBET (LOWBUSH)	60cm	60cm	A compact, dwarf variety, leaves range from pink to orange to green.	Full sun/Part shade	5
POLARIS (HALF-HIGH)	1.25m	1.5m	Crops of tangy, sweet, light blue fruit in early summer.	Full sun/Part shade	3
ST. CLOUD (HALF-HIGH)	1.25m	1.5m	Bushy, upright habit. Large, sweet blue fruit in mid-summer.	Full sun/Part shade	3

CONCORD (BLUE)	10m	2m	Juicy, sweet and excellent for eating and juice. Ripens late October.	Full sun	5
CONCORD SEEDLESS (BLUE)	7m	1.5m	Similar to 'Concord' but clusters of smaller berries	Full sun	5
FREDONIA (DRK BLUE)	9m	2m	Vigorous, black grape. Good quality. Ripens late September.	Full sun	4
HIMROD SEEDLESS (WHITE)	8m	2m	A yellow- gold variety that ripens mid/late September.	Full sun	5
INTERLAKEN SEEDLESS	7m	2m	Golden yellow with medium sized fruit. Table grape.	Full sun	5
NIAGARA (LRG WHITE)	8m	2m	White, large and very sweet, prolific. Ripens late September.	Full sun	6
SAUVIGNON BLANC	4.5m	60cm	A popular green skinned grape, crisp and fruity.	Full sun	6
SOVEREIGN CORONATION (BLUE) SEEDLESS	8m	2m	Ripens mid-September. Vigorous vine produces large clusters.	Full sun	4
VANESSA SEEDLESS (RED)	8m	2m	A deep-red, medium seedless grape. Ripens mid-September.	Full sun	6

BLACK RASPBERRY	1.8m	1m	Native variety.	Full sun/Part shade	4
BOYNE	2m	2m	Medium size fruit quite resistant to spur blight. Ripens July.	Full sun	2
EVER-FALL GOLD	2m	2m	Golden yellow, ever bearing variety. Fruit is large, sweet & juicy.	Full sun	5
EVER-HERITAGE	2m	2m	Vigorous grower with medium sized red fruit.	Full sun	4
JEWEL (BLACK)	1.5m	1m	Heavy producer. Juicy, purple-black fruit. Delicious fresh.	Full sun	4
PURPLE - ROYALTY	2m	1m	A cross between a purple and a red raspberry. Large fruit size.	Full sun	3

EVERBEARING ALBION	30cm	60cm	Sweeter than most, high yields of conical berries with a firm texture.	Full sun/Part shade	3
KENT	15cm	45cm	Firm, red, mid-season fruit. Vigorous and productive. Mild flavor.	Full sun/Part shade	3
SEASCAPE	30cm	1m	Large fruit, good flavor, and high yield. An ever-bearing selection.	Full sun/Part shade	4
VEESTAR	30cm	1m	An early, very productive variety. Good size, flavor, bright red.	Full sun/Part shade	4

ASPARAGUS M. WASHINGTON	30cm	45cm	Hardy, long-lived and a heavy producer of tall tender delicious shoots.	Full sun/Part shade	2
ASPARAGUS VIKING	1m	50cm	All male plant. Resists asparagus rust.	Full sun/Part shade	4
CURRENT BLACK WELLINGTON	1.5m	1.5m	Soft black berry clusters are medium large. Produces an abundance of fruit.	Full sun/Part shade	2
CURRENT RED LAKE	1.5m	1.5m	Clusters of large bright red berries borne on wood. Semi-erect.	Full sun/Part shade	3
CURRENT WHITE PEARL	1.5m	1.5m	Edible white fruit with a greenish tinge. Good for jelly, jam or wine.	Full sun/Part shade	3
GOJI BERRY DYNAMITE	2m	2m	Larger than other varieties, bittersweet, rich in vitamins, antioxidants.	Full sun/Part shade	5
GOJI BERRY FIRECRACKER	1.8m	2.5m	Purple blooms in the late spring, red berries that are antioxidant-rich.	Full sun/Part shade	5
GOOSEBERRY PIXWELL	1.5m	1m	Thorn less, yellow-green fruit mature to salmon pink when ripe.	Full sun/Part shade	3
HORSERADISH	60cm	90cm	White flowers above large, glossy green foliage; roots are used.	Full sun/Part shade	2
JERUSALEM ARTICHOKE	1.5m	1.2m	Thistle-like flowers can be eaten like artichokes when unopened.	Full sun	1
