<b>COLORADO SPRUCE</b>					
BABY BLUE EYES BLUE SPRUCE	5m	3m	Slower growing with bright blue colour.	Pyramid	3
BABY BLUE SPRUCE	8m	4.5m	Blue green foliage, a dense habit with full, stout branches. Extremely hardy and rugged.	Pyramid	2
COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE	20m	5m	Blue to semi-blue colour. Nice as specimen or group planting	Pyramid	2
COLORADO SPRUCE	20m	4.5m	Strong hardy grower. Grey-green to blue-green colour.	Pyramid	2
FAT ALBERT BLUE SPRUCE	5m	2.5m	Slow growing. Maintains shape well. Vivid blue.	Pyramid	3
NORTH POLE WHITE SPRUCE	3.5m	1.2m	A slow growing, columnar selection with short upswept branches. Bright green new foliage mature gray-green.	Columnar	4
SERBIAN SPRUCE	2m	4.5m	A very attractive ornamental spruce that has silvery green leaves. A desirable lawn specimen. Slow growing.	Pyramid	4
<b>NORWAY SPRUCE</b>					
CUPRESSINA NORWAY SPRUCE	10m	2m	Slower growing with extremely narrow habit. Dense branching.	Columnar	3
NORWAY SPRUCE	25m	10m	Tall, rapid growing. Used as windbreak or specimen plant.	Pyramid	2
<b>WHITE SPRUCE</b>					
DWARF ALBERTA SPRUCE	2m	1.25m	Distinct conical shape. Slow growing; bright green foliage.	Pyramid	4
WHITE SPRUCE	25m	4.5m	Hardy, shapely tree. Dark green needles. Native.	Pyramid	2
<b>OTHER SPRUCE</b>					
SERBIAN SPRUCE	21m	4.5m	Semi-pendulous branches with bicolour blue and green needles.	Pyramid	5
<b>MOUNDED &amp; GLOBE</b>					
ACROCONA PUSCH NORWAY	30cm	60cm	Dwarf spreading, green needles. Tiny cones, red in the spring, brown in summer	Mounded	3
FAT CAT NORWAY SPRUCE	1.2m	1.2m	Dense rounded dwarf form. Very short, stiff needles on short shoots.	Round	2
GLOBE BLUE SPRUCE	80cm	1.5m	Dwarf form, Silvery blue in late spring turns to green-blue in summer.	Globe	2
LITTLE GEM SPRUCE	50cm	60cm	A nice dense growing dwarf spruce. Excellent for the rock garden.	Globe	4
NEST SPRUCE	80cm	1.5m	Has a nest-like appearance. Low and broad growing. Slow growth habit.	Mounded	3
