CAYUGA KOREANSPICE	1.5m	1.5m	Pink buds, that open to white, Tolerant to mildew and leaf spot	Sun/Part Sun	6
EUROPEAN SNOWBALL	2.5m	3m	Large globular white flower clusters in May/June. Fruitless	Sun/Part Sun	3
HEDGE	60cm	80cm	Globe shaped compact bush, ideal low hedge	Sun/Part Sun	4

MARIES DOUBLEFILE	2.5m	2.5m	Large flowers in spring, Interesting horizontal branching habit	Full sun/Part sun	6
POPCORN	2.5m	2.5m	Hundreds of small round popcorn-like balls line the branches	Full sun/Part sun	5
SHASTA DOUBLEFILE	1.75m	2.5m	Large white masses of flowers in May, Slow growing selection	Full sun/Part sun	6
